THE I.O.O.F. CALIFORNIA STATE FAIR BOOTH COMING SOON!!

The application for the California State Fair IOOF Booth has been submitted! Thanks to the lodges that have given to this worthy IOOF event. But,

the IOOF booth still needs contributions from our lodges. The focus is the Living Legacy Program, where the I.O.O.F. presents one of its most important programs. We plant primarily trees, but all vegetation. We plant trees for the environment. Since 1991, this has been an official program and focus of our Order.

We share this goal with the public at the State Fair, so they learn a little more about what we do as Odd Fellows and Rebekahs. We were surprised to learn that many people did not know the Order planted trees and encouraged the planting of trees. Luckily, our volunteers at the booth are there to inform and create awareness.

One year, we gave away over 1000 seedlings in a single weekend. Last year, we shared other organization's tree planting programs. For the past three years, we have received the support of the arborists, who are also in the same building as the I.O.O.F. booth. They provide brochures to compliment our brochure on the planting of trees.

This July, we have something very special to share with the public that deals directly with trees, more specifically, the Sequoia National Forest. We learned this past year, that of the three named trees in this forest, one of them was reported to be named and dedicated the "I.O.O.F. Tree" in 1903. This tree was located and photographed for us. An outside historian brought this to our attention. We are grateful. He thought that if worked with the Superintendent of the National Park Service that the I.O.O.F. could rededicate the tree. The booth at the State Fair allows us to bring awareness to people.

With your kind donations, we can continue sharing one of our most important programs with nearly a million fair goers over a 16-day stretch this coming July. We need your support.
